## B.C. company builds green parking lot at Denver Airport

Vancouver-based Greenscape Capital is opening what it describes as the world's greenest parking facility on Wednesday at Denver International Airport.

The 4,200-stall Canopy Airport Parking lot has been built to LEED Gold certification standards and incorporates energy saving features including solar and wind power, geothermal heating and cooling.

Greenscape is hoping that the lot will serve as a demonstration model towards development of similar facilities, and upgrades to existing lots, across North America.

It's the first project for Greenscape, which will operate Canopy in partnership with Propark America. Other partners include BMW DesignworksUSA and Frontier Airlines.

Total cost of the facility is \$30.9 million and the company anticipates annual net operating income of \$5.1 million after the facility's initial year in business.
